SUBJECT: Order Authorizing a Tariff Schedule Exception to be Effective on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by letter dated July 16, 1964, having requested authority under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from Rule No. 2(i) of its tariff schedules for gas served in the Monolith-Tehachapi Supply District "G", Kern County effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely retroactive to the period May 1, 1964 through June 30, 1964, and

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, having further requested authority under Section VII of General Order No. 96-A to withdraw its Advice Letter No. 601 in conjunction therewith, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from Rule No. 2(i) of the filed tariff schedules for gas service in Monolith-Tehachapi Supply District "G" during the period May 1, 1964 through June 30, 1964

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets transmitted with Advice Letter No. 601 shall be marked to show that such sheets were rejected under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1241.
