SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from the
Requirements of General Order No. 96-A

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 609, filed
December 2, 1964, has requested authority under Sections 455 and 489-491
of the Public Utilities Code to reduce applicable rates by rezoning to
lower rate levels those certain rate areas as designated and set forth
in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9275-G to 9281-G, inclusive, and 9288-G and
9289-G, to be effective February 1, 1965, and

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY has further requested that
the rates to be made effective on February 1, 1965 for the above sheets
be applicable to meter readings on and after said date, therefore, good
cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 489-491 of the
Public Utilities Code to make said effective date of such sheets appli-
cable for meter readings taken on and after said date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such
