SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increases.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 608 filed December 2, 1964, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make revisions in its tariff schedules as designated in Schedule No. G-60, Resale Natural Gas Service, Schedule No. G-60-TO, Temporary Optional Resale Natural Gas Service, Third Supplemental Gas Service Agreement with the City of Long Beach and Table of Contents as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9139-G to 9148-G, inclusive, effective on January 1, 1965, and

WHEREAS: These changes are to offset a decrease in Long Beach's own-source gas supply and to anticipate 5500 additional customers resulting from Application No. 47136 filed November 20, 1964, and

WHEREAS: We find that such increases resulting from the revisions in the tariff schedules are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on January 1, 1965.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1252.
