SUBJECT: Order Authorizing a Contract to be Effective  
on Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, by Advice Letter No. 485, filed February 17, 1965, having requested authority under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely on January 1, 1965, a temporary contract instead of continuing service to Los Angeles Department of Water and Power under Schedule No. G-54S, and

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA requests that this filing be made effective on January 1, 1965 inasmuch as negotiations for said contract were made with the understanding that the gas company would request that the contract be made effective on said date; and, good cause appearing,
