SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Territorial Boundary Lines

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 616, filed February 18, 1965, having requested authority to make adjustments to its territorial boundary line with Long Beach Municipal Gas Department, that was established by Decision No. 62381, dated August 8, 1961, in Application No. 43558, and further necessary modification of the boundary between Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California as established by Decision No. 56878, dated June 24, 1958, in Application No. 39636, as shown on the map covering the territorial boundary lines between the Southern California Gas Company and Long Beach Municipal Gas Department, and also covered by territorial boundary descriptions, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9309-G through 9312-G, and

WHEREAS: Long Beach Municipal Gas Department is presently serving natural gas in an area where Southern California Gas Company has no facilities, and

WHEREAS: Revision of said portion of the common boundary between Southern California Gas Company and Long Beach Municipal Gas Department and further necessary modification of said boundary between Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California, are hereby found to be in the public interest under these particular circumstances, and therefore, good cause appearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted to make the above sheets effective on regular statutory notice, namely, on March 20, 1965, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1261.
