RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from the
Requirements of General Order No. 96-A

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, by Advice Letter
No. 487, filed March 2, 1965, having requested authority under Sections
455 and 490 of the Public Utilities Code to reduce applicable rates by
rezoning to lower rate levels those certain rate areas as designated and
set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 4081-G to 4093-G, inclusive, to be
effective April 1, 1965, and

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA having further
requested that the rates to be made effective on April 1, 1965 for the
above sheets be applicable to meter readings on and after said date,
therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 490 of the Public
Utilities Code to make said effective date of such sheets applicable
for meter readings taken on and after said date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such
sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission
of the State of California No. G-1264.
