SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviations From Filed Tariffs for a Gas Main Extension.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 511-G, filed March 15, 1965, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15.E.7 and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules with respect to waiving gas main extension advances for all customers and the required three year service contracts for general service customers in the extension of natural gas service to Clements and Ione, and as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 7603-G to 7607-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: This main extension is to furnish gas for general service, firm industrial service, and interruptible service, thereby making it impractical to allocate or separate the respective extension installation costs by types of service, and

WHEREAS: Special conditions which will provide adequate earnings will be agreed upon by the customer prior to commencing construction, and

WHEREAS: Such deviations from the filed tariffs will facilitate procurement of the necessary applications for natural gas service, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said tariff sheets effective on April 14, 1965.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1267.
