SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Change in Rate Area Boundaries Which Will Result in a Technical Increase.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, by Advice Letter No. 489, filed March 18, 1965, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 455 of the Public Utilities Code to revise the boundary between its Rate Area No. 5 and Rate Area No. 6, as designated and set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 4094-G to 4098-G, inclusive, to be effective April 17, 1965, and

WHEREAS: Transfer of a presently unserved six acre parcel from Rate Area No. 5 to Rate Area No. 6 will result in potentially increased charges at the rates now in effect, thus resulting in a technical increase, and

WHEREAS: We find that such technical increase resulting from the revision of the boundary between these rate areas is justified, therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said tariff sheets effective on regular statutory notice, namely, April 17, 1965.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1268.
