SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from Filed Tariff Schedules

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by letter of April 14, 1965, filed April 15, 1965, having requested authority to deviate from the "Adjustment Applicable to Overrun Gas" clause contained in Schedules Nos. G-54L, G-54M and G-54S, and to prorate as set forth in the letter attachments the adjustment for the nine-month period ended December 31, 1964, and

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY further requested to make these overrun gas adjustments as credits on the bills covering service for the month of April 1965, and

WHEREAS: The customers designated to receive such credit adjustments for the nine-month period ended December 31, 1964 elected to obtain service as of January 1, 1965 under alternate schedules at reduced rates; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to credit said proration adjustments on bills issued on or after May 1, 1965.
