SUBJECT: Order Authorizing a Contract to be Effective on Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING GAS SUPPLY COMPANY by Advice No.27, filed May 14, 1965, requests authority to carry out the terms and conditions of a letter agreement dated May 13, 1965 covering transfer and resale to Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California of storage gas declared excess by Pacific Gas and Electric Company, and

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING GAS SUPPLY COMPANY has been authorized by Resolution No. G-1276 to purchase any such gas that Pacific Gas and Electric Company makes available; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to furnish the service under the conditions and in accordance with the terms and conditions of said contract and to make the contract effective on May 25, 1965.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract hereinabove authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1277.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Lighting Gas Supply Company shall notify the Commission of the date of termination of said contract within thirty days after date of termination.
