SUBJECT: Order Retroactively Authorizing Deviation
from Filed Tariff Schedules.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by letter of May 13, 1965, having requested authority to deviate from its gas tariff schedules and to make credit adjustments in bill charged to Monolith Portland Cement Company for gas delivered during the period November 1964 through March 1965, and

WHEREAS: The adjusted billing appropriately reflects a representative effective rate level of 1100 Btu for the gas mixture delivered to Monolith in such period; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 532 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to credit said adjustments on bills issued to Monolith Portland Cement Company for gas furnished during the period November 1964 through March 1965.
