SUBJECT: Request of Utility for Extension of Deviation

WHEREAS: Southern Counties Gas Company of California has by letter dated June 4, 1965, requested a one-year extension of a deviation from Rule 24(a) of General Order No. 58-A authorized by Resolution Nos. G-1221, dated March 3, 1964 and G-1248, dated November 30, 1964, and

WHEREAS: The purpose of the extension of the deviation is to enable the staff and the utility to complete studies toward the objective of a permanent plan for performance control of testing gas meters for accuracy, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the deviation authorized by Resolution No. G-1221, shall be extended to July 1, 1966 and under the following conditions:

1. All new meters will be tested in accordance with General Order No. 58-A. New meters and reprocessed meters having synthetic diaphragms shall be set at a control standard of $-\frac{1}{4}\%$ $\pm\frac{1}{4}\%$.
2. A meter group will be scheduled for removal as soon as more than 10% of the meters in the group are indicated to be registering more than 2% fast, or as soon as more than 20% of the meters in the group are indicated to be registering outside the range of 2% fast to 2% slow, on the basis of tests of sample meters from the group.
3. Meter groups 10 and 19 shall be removed from service by June 30, 1966.
4. The meter shop and field work forces will be expanded to accommodate these changes.
