SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 632, filed June 21, 1965, having requested authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely July 1, 1965, the extension of the termination date of Rate Schedule No. G-60-TO, Temporary Optional Resale Natural Gas Service, to the City of Long Beach, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9392-G through 9398-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The contract for gas sales by the City of Long Beach to Southern California Edison Company provides that the rates paid to the City by Edison shall be based on the average monthly rate paid by Edison to Southern Counties Gas Company for gas sales to the Alamitos and Huntington Beach steam-electric plants and such contract covering the sales by Counties to Edison terminates on March 31, 1966, and

WHEREAS: By extending the termination date of Schedule No. G-60-TO to coincide with the termination date of Southern Counties Gas Company's special contract for gas service to Edison will permit continued competitive rates to the City of Long Beach, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on July 1, 1965.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1287.
