SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contracts Filed Under Section X.
Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96-A

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 638 filed August 2, 1965, having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective a new contract dated July 1, 1965 (which will supersede and replace the original contract dated March 24, 1961) covering the transfer from Schedule No. G-50 to Schedule No. G-53A for service to Union Carbide Corporation-Linde Division's liquid hydrogen plant at Fontana, California, such interruptible gas to be used primarily as a raw material and without standby equipment, and,

WHEREAS: The supplying of interruptible natural gas service on said schedules without standby equipment is a deviation from the utilities filed tariff schedules, and

WHEREAS: Such deviation was previously authorized for service under Schedule No. G-50 by Decision No. 62013, dated May 22, 1961, in Application No. 43315; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utility Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said contract.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. C-1293.
