SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract to be Effective on Less
Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by letter dated September 2, 1965, requests authority to carry out the terms and conditions of a letter agreement dated April 6, 1965, covering resale of certain excess gas to Pacific Lighting Gas Supply Company, and

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING GAS SUPPLY COMPANY has a market for any such excess gas that Pacific Gas and Electric Company makes available by resale or release; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to furnish the service under the conditions and in accordance with the terms and conditions of said contract and to make said contract effective on September 21, 1965.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract hereinabove authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1295.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall notify the Commission of the date of termination of said contract within thirty days after date of termination.
