> SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING GAS SUPPLY COMPANY by letter dated October 26, 1965, having requested authority under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to (1) revise the presently effective commodity charge for sales of peaking gas or emergency gas on Rate Schedule No. G-62, Resale Natural Gas Service, (2) divide the presently defined emergency gas into two categories as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 223-G through 228-G, inclusive, effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely, on November 5, 1965, and

WHEREAS: Such aforementioned revision of the commodity charge reflects a reduction from cost plus ten per cent to cost plus one cent per Mcf, and

WHEREAS: No finding is made as to the reasonableness of the contracts between Pacific Lighting Gas Supply Company and the California Producers for the purchase of peaking gas or emergency gas; therefore, good cause appearing.

IT IS WRDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on November 5, 1965.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that granting of such authority to revise said commodity charge for sale of peaking gas or emergency gas shall not be construed as a finding as to the reasonablenss of the contracts between Pacific Lighting Gas Supply Company and the California Producers for the purchase of such gas.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1297.
