SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules That
Will Result in Withdrawal of a Rate Schedule.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by letter dated November 24, 1965, having requested authority under Sections Nos. 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to cancel Rate Schedule No. G-54M, Optional Long-Term Interruptible Natural Gas Service to Cement Plants, Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9362-G, 8978-G, 8979-G, 8980-G, 8981-G, 9624-G and related contract form Sheet No. 8985-G, and

WHEREAS: There are no customers presently served on Schedule No. G-54M as alternate schedules currently effective are more acceptable to present customers, and

WHEREAS: All cement plant customers were contacted and none expressed any objection to the cancellation of said schedule; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the cancellation of said sheets effective on December 26, 1965.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were cancelled under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1300.
