SUBJECT: Order Authorizing a Contract Filed Under Section X,
Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96-A

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 198-G, filed November 30, 1965, having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective Special Contract No. 148, executed October 4, 1965, covering gas service to Garnair, Inc., located near Palomar Airport, San Diego County, such gas to be supplied from an existing extension which was authorized by Resolution No. G-1080, dated October 6, 1958, and

WHEREAS: The conditions of Special Contract No. 148 provides for a monthly charge not covered by the utility's filed tariffs, and

WHEREAS: Garnair, Inc., agrees to pay a required additional monthly prorated charge applicable to the existing extension; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be given under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said contract.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1301.
