SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviations From Filed Tariffs for
 a Gas Main Extension

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 535-G, filed December 24, 1965, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15.E.7 and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules with respect to waiving gas main extension advances for all customers in the extension of natural gas service to Paradise in Butte County, and as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 7795-G to 7798-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Special conditions which will provide adequate earnings will be agreed upon by the customer prior to commencing construction, and

WHEREAS: Such deviations from the filed tariffs will facilitate procurement of the necessary applications for natural gas service, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said tariff sheets effective on January 4, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1305.
