RESOLUTION

**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Deviations from Filed Tariffs  
 for a Gas Main Extension

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 538-G, filed January 14, 1966, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15.E.7. and Section Nos. 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to continue effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely, on January 15, 1966, certain deviations from its filed Gas Tariff Schedules for the natural gas main extension in San Geronimo Valley, Marin County, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 7838-G and 7839-G, and

**WHEREAS:** Such continuation of the solicitation period until June 1, 1966, has been requested by the directors of the San Geronimo Valley Association in order to procure the necessary service application, and

**WHEREAS:** This main extension is to furnish gas for general service along some 23 miles of distribution mains, thereby making it impractical to allocate or separate the respective extension installation costs by customers, and

**WHEREAS:** Special conditions applicable to this extension will be agreed upon by each customer prior to commencing construction, and therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said tariff sheets effective on January 15, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1306
