SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Results in Reduction of Service and a Technical Increase.

WHEREAS: SCUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA. by Advice No. 501, filed December 30, 1965, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective changes in the sample contract form used with Schedule No. G-60, Wholesale Natural Gas, as set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 4213-G to 4221-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The utility alleges that it is not possible to assure maintenance of guaranteed pressures in the Moreno line when volumes of gas are delivered in excess of contract demand, and

WHEREAS: These sample contract form changes are consistent with the base intent of executing revised agreements without the necessity of refileing the effective natural gas wholesale contract form for service between Southern Counties Gas Company of California and San Diego Gas & Electric Company as approved by Resolution No. G-1179 on October 23, 1962 in Advice No. 434 of Southern Counties Gas Company of California, and

WHEREAS: Such proposed changes in the service contract provides for more equitable procedures with respect to the handling of demand charges and in procedures that may be followed during an emergency, the Commission finds that any increase in rates which may result and the service reduction are justified, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on January 29, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1307.
