SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviations from Tariff Schedules.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 537-G, filed January 12, 1966, having requested authority under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to (1) make delayed revisions in the effective rate level of natural gas supplied to Isleton Rate Area as set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 7828-G and 7837-G to be effective for meter readings on and after January 15, 1966, and (2) to waive the undercharges for service in the Isleton Rate Area during the period November 15, 1965 to January 15, 1966, and

WHEREAS: Such revisions of effective rate level for the Isleton Rate Area is basically in accordance with the utility's Rule No. 2(c) and will reflect the actual heat content of the gas served, and

WHEREAS: Waiving of the undercharges that have incurred is not adverse to the public welfare, therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make such sheets covering gas service in the Isleton Rate Area effective on January 15, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1308.
