RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan on Less than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING SERVICE AND SUPPLY COMPANY by letter filed March 14, 1966, having requested authority to place into effect a refund plan on less than thirty days' notice, namely, before the first billing cycle in April of its affiliated customers, Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California

WHEREAS: The proposed refund plan proposes to refund to Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company customers, Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California, amounts obtained through savings in income taxes for the years 1965 and 1966 derived from changes in depreciation accounting for income tax purposes, and

WHEREAS: The utility's customers, Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California propose placing into effect refund plans including the amounts refunded by the utility commencing with the beginning of their respective first billing cycles in April and requests authorization by March 29, 1966, and, good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company is authorized to place in effect on March 29, 1966, the refund plan filed on March 14, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company shall keep records of the refunds made and submit a report of the disposition of such monies to the Commission for a final disposition of unrefunded amounts.
