SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan on Less than
 Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by letter filed March 14, 1966, having requested authority to place into effect on less than thirty days' notice, namely, before the first billing cycle in April, 1966, a refund plan,

WHEREAS: The proposed refund plan proposes to refund to customers amounts obtained through savings in income taxes for the years 1965 and 1966 derived from changes in depreciation accounting for income tax purposes, and

WHEREAS: The utility plans to make such refunds to customers beginning with the first customer billing cycle in April, 1966, and therefore requests an authorization by March 29, 1966, and, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company is authorized to place in effect on March 29, 1966, the refund plan filed on March 14, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company shall keep records of the refunds made and submit a report of the disposition of such monies to the Commission for a final disposition of unrefunded amounts.
