SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviations From Filed Tariffs
For a Gas Main Extension

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 543-G, filed April 29, 1966, having requested authority under its Rule 15.E.7 and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules with respect to waiving gas main extension advances for customers in the extension of natural gas service from a point north of the Alexander Valley Road and U. S. Highway 101 near Healdsburg to the cities of Cloverdale and Ukiah, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 7867-G to 7872-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: This main extension is to furnish gas for general service, firm industrial service, and interruptible service, thereby making it impractical to allocate or separate the respective extension installation costs by types of service, and

WHEREAS: The utility presently serves propane gas to the City of Ukiah and by Application No. 48345, filed March 25, 1966, seeks Commission authorization to purchase Cloverdale Gas Company, and

WHEREAS: Such deviation from the filed gas tariffs will facilitate completion of this natural gas extension, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said tariff sheets effective on May 29, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission No. G-1322.
