SUBJECT: Order Waiving Effective Rate Decrease in Tariff Schedules
for Heating Value Change Which Results in a Technical
Increase

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 545-G, having
requested authority under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities
Code to waive application of the utility's Rule No. 2(c) to Schedules
Nos. G-40, G-45, G-50, and G-53 within the Btu Area supplied from
Main 50 between Richvale Wye and Valve 21.62, and

WHEREAS: There are no customers in this Btu area served under Schedules
Nos. G-40, G-45, G-50 and G-53, and

WHEREAS: Authorization was granted by Resolution No. G-1323 to convert
the above rate schedules from the present volumetric rate structure to a
therm rate structure, for meter readings on and after May 31, 1966, and

WHEREAS: We find that the technical increase resulting from the waiver of
Rule 2(c) in the period May 15, 1966 through May 30, 1966, under these
circumstances is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 532 of the
Public Utilities Code to waive application of Rule No. 2(c) in the Btu
Area served from Main 50 from Richvale Wye to Valve 21.62 for Rate Schedules
Nos. G-40, G-45, G-50 and G-53.
