SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Continuation of Deviations from Filed Tariffs for a Gas Main Extension on Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 548-G, filed July 8, 1966, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15.E.7 and Sections Nos. 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to continue authorized deviations from its filed Gas Tariff Schedules for the extension of natural gas service to Paradise in Butte County, on less than 30 days notice, namely on July 24, 1966, and as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 7899-G and 7900-G, and

WHEREAS: Such continuation of the solicitation period until October 1, 1966 has been requested by the Paradise Chamber of Commerce in order to facilitate the procurement of the necessary service applications, and

WHEREAS: Special conditions applicable to this extension will be agreed upon by each individual customer prior to commencing construction; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said tariff sheets effective on July 24, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1328.
