SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Change in Tariff Schedules Which Will
Result in Increases in Rates

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 550-G filed July 29, 1966, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 490 of the Public Utilities Code to make revisions in its tariff schedules by adopting therm rates as the billing basis for meter readings taken on and after May 31, 1966, as set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 7905-G to 7937-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Adoption of said therm rates will provide a billing method directly related to the heat content of the gas, and

WHEREAS: We find that such increases resulting from the above changes in tariff schedules are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 490 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on August 29, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1332.
