SUBJECT: Order Authorizing a Contract Filed Under Section X,
 Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96-A

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 207-G, filed August 10, 1966, having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective Special Contract No. 153, executed June 27, 1966, covering gas service to Hughes Tool Company - Aircraft Division, located near Palomar Airport, San Diego County, such gas to be supplied from the existing extension which was authorized by Resolution No. G-1081, dated October 28, 1958, and

WHEREAS: The conditions of Special Contract No. 153 provides for an extra monthly charge not covered by the utility's filed tariffs, and

WHEREAS: The additional charge set forth in Special Contract No. 153 is conditioned on Commission authorization of Special Contract No. 151, submitted by Advice No. 206-G, and

WHEREAS: Hughes Tool Company - Aircraft Division, agrees to pay such additional prorated charge toward the existing extension; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be given under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said contract and to make the contract effective on September 9, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1334.
