SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract Filed Under Section X,

Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96-A

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by letter dated August 5, 1966, requests authority to carry out terms and conditions of letter agreement dated July 26, 1966, covering resale of certain excess gas to Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company, and

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING SERVICE AND SUPPLY COMPANY has need for such gas to prevent drastic curtailment of its interruptible market and to improve its margin of supply for the extreme peak-day situation, and

WHEREAS: No finding is being made as to the reasonableness of the price being paid by Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the utility be granted authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to furnish service under the conditions and in accordance with the terms of said contract and to make said contract effective on September 6, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the granting of such authority shall not be construed as a finding as to the reasonableness of the prices to be paid by Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract hereinabove authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1340.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall notify the Commission of the date of termination of said contract within thirty days after date of termination.
