SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract Filed Under Section X,
Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96-A

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 553-G filed September 29, 1966, having requested authority under Sections 490 and 532 to carry out the terms and conditions of a contract dated June 28, 1963, with the State of California, Department of Water Resources, covering the providing of gas service to the State's temporary headquarters near Oroville, in Butte County, and

WHEREAS: Giving consideration to the cost of the facilities required to serve gas to the proposed site and the estimated annual revenue involved, the contract contains provisions for cost of ownership charges, a five-year term, refunds determined on gross revenues, 20 accelerated refunds, and withholds other refunds, and

WHEREAS: The Department of Water Resources' normally required advance is reduced by \$4,759, and,

WHEREAS: The Department of Water Resources of the State of California is in agreement with such other deviations as set forth in the contract; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 490 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said contract.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said contract be marked to show that it was authorized under resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1346.
