SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by letter filed October 17, 1966, having requested authority to refund amounts to customers in accordance with a refund plan to rebate 1966 savings in federal and state income taxes, and

WHEREAS: The proposed rebate represents an amount realized from savings related to use of liberalized depreciation on plant additions for the years 1954-1964, inclusive, and additional reduction in tax and franchise fees resulting from the rebate; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Gas & Electric Company is authorized to place in effect the refund plan filed on October 17, 1966, and shall keep records of the refunds made and submit a report by July 31, 1967, of the disposition of such monies for final disposition of unrefunded amounts.
