**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in a Technical Rate Increase and Modification of Boundaries Established by Commission Orders

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 681, filed October 24, 1966, having requested authority under Section 454, 455 and 490 of the Public Utilities Code to revise the boundaries of certain rate areas established by Decisions Nos. 47990 and 66094 and replace written descriptions of certain rate areas with rate area maps, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9806-G to 9814-G, inclusive, and

**WHEREAS:** These proposed rate area revisions will result in an initial estimated annual revenue reduction of \$1,175, and

**WHEREAS:** The proposed revisions of the rate area boundaries constitute minor revisions of boundaries established by prior orders of this Commission, and

**WHEREAS:** the rates resulting from revision of the Corona-La Sierra rate area boundary will only result in technical increases, and we find that such increases resulting from such boundary change are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

**IT IS ORDERED** that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 490 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on November 23, 1966.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1350.
