SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Change in Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice Which Will Result in Increase in Charges

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 10, filed November 3, 1966, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely on December 1, 1966, certain revisions in its tariff schedules, reflecting increased cost of liquid petroleum gas, as designated in Schedules Nos. G-82 and G-83, General Service Seasonal and General Service Permanent, respectively, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 76-G to 78-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: We find that such increases resulting from the above revisions in tariff schedules are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on December 1, 1966.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1352.
