**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA by Advice Letter No. 535, filed February 24, 1967, having requested authority under its Rule No. 20, E.7. and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules by the waiving of gas main extension advances for the proposed extension of natural gas service to two small areas near the communities of Ballard and Los Olivos in Santa Barbara County, and

**WHEREAS:** In granting the authorization requested, the Commission states that if it should appear in future proceedings that there are deficiencies in earnings from this extension, such deficiencies are not to be imposed upon the utility's other gas customers; therefore, good cause appearing,

**IT IS ORDERED** that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from the provisions of Rule No. 20, Gas Main Extensions, by waiving main extension advances for the extension of natural gas service to the two small areas near the communities of Ballard and Los Olivos in Santa Barbara County.
