SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract for Sale of Gas to be Effective on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 694, filed March 15, 1967, and SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA by Advice Letter No. 537, filed March 15, 1967, having each requested authority under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than statutory notice, namely, on March 16, 1967, a contract dated March 14, 1967, for the sale of gas to the Los Angeles Department of Water & Power on an emergency basis until April 15, 1967, and,

WHEREAS: No finding is being made as to the reasonableness of the price to be paid by the Los Angeles Department of Water & Power; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on March 16, 1967, the joint contract dated March 14, 1967, between Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California, and the Los Angeles Department of Water & Power.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1365.
