SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will  
 Result in Increased Charges on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice No. 696, filed March 20, 1967, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely on April 1, 1967, certain changes in its tariff schedules which will establish a new rate area and result in increased charges to two customers, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9962-G to 9969-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Such establishment of a new rate area will result in more equitable billing to the majority of customers affected with respect to the heating value of gas received, and

WHEREAS: We find that such increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on April 1, 1967.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1367.
