R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviations From Filed Tariff Schedules
for a Gas Main Extension

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 560-G, filed April 5, 1967, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15.E.7 and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules by waiving gas main extension advances for the proposed extension of natural gas service to Upper Carmel Valley, Monterey County, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8003-G through 8008-G, inclusive, and


WHEREAS: In granting the authorization requested, the Commission states that if it should appear in future proceedings that there are deficiencies in earnings from this extension, such deficiencies are not to be imposed upon the utility's other gas customers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from the provisions of Rule No. 15, Gas Main Extensions, by waiving main extension advances for the extension of natural gas service to Upper Carmel Valley, and to make said tariff sheets effective on May 5, 1967.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1371.
