**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing a Contract Filed Under Section X, Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96-A, on Less Than Statutory Notice

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 706, filed April 21, 1967, and SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA by Advice Letter No. 544, filed April 21, 1967, having requested authority under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than statutory notice, namely on April 1, 1967, a contract executed April 20, 1967, for the sale of gas to Southern California Edison Company of a temporary basis, and

**WHEREAS:** The presently effective contract, by its own terms, expires on April 1, 1967, and

**WHEREAS:** Commission authorization of the proposed continuing contract is temporarily withheld pending further investigation; therefore, good cause appearing,

**IT IS ORDERED** that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on April 1, 1967, the joint temporary contract executed April 20, 1967, between Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California and Southern California Edison Company.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1372.
