SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by letter dated May 25, 1967, having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to place a refund plan into effect, and

WHEREAS: The proposed refund plan represents a flow-through to customers of El Paso Natural Gas Company resulting from a refund ordered by the Federal Power Commission in Docket No. RP 67-9, by order issued April 3, 1967, and

WHEREAS: The refund to Pacific Gas and Electric Company is proposed to be distributed by check or credit in its entirety among all eligible gas customers except utility-owned steam-electric generating stations and the utility's steam heat department; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to place into effect the refund plan filed on May 25, 1967.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall keep records of the refunds made and submit a report of the disposition of such monies to this Commission by October 31, 1967, for final disposition of any amounts unrefunded.
