WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 561-G,  
filed May 11, 1967, having requested authority under Section 491 of the  
Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than 30 days' notice  
certain revisions in its tariff schedules, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C.  
Sheets Nos. 8009-G through 8037-G, and

WHEREAS: The above requested reductions are found to be reasonable and  
in the public interest; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public  
Utilities Code to make said sheets effective for meter readings taken on  
and after June 10, 1967.
