SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which  
Will Result in Increased Charges

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA by Advice Letter No. 546, filed May 15, 1967, having requested authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Rule No. 20, Gas Main Extensions, and Rule No. 21, Gas Service Extensions, by increasing charges for gas piping in excess of the free footage allowance, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 4469-G to 4472-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Said rules contain provisions covering revision of these charges when costs of installation have changed by more than 10%, and the proposed charges, based on 1966 construction costs, exceed the costs now on file by more than 10%, and

WHEREAS: The foregoing increased charges are found to be reasonable and not adverse to the public interest; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on June 20, 1967, and that the sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1376.
