SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract Under Section X, Subsection A,
of General Order No. 96-A

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 707, filed jointly with SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA'S Advice Letter No. 547 on May 29, 1967, having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective a contract dated May 4, 1967, for the sale of gas to the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power under Schedule No. G-58, and


WHEREAS: The contract contains a provision that it shall not become effective until authorization of this Commission is first obtained; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective, for meter readings commencing on July 1, 1967, the joint contract dated May 4, 1967, between Southern California Gas Company, Southern Counties Gas Company of California, and the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1378.
