SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Reductions in Charges Through Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 47-G, filed June 9, 1967, having requested authority under Sections 455, 490, and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than 30 days' notice certain revisions in its gas tariffs, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 220-G through 230-G, and

WHEREAS: The above reductions complete the utility's transition to therm rates; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 490 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective for meter readings taken on and after June 30, 1967.
