SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from Filed Tariffs
on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA by Advice Letter No. 557, filed August 23, 1967, having requested authority under its Rule No. 20.E.7. and Sections 455, 491, and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules by the waiving of gas main extension advances for a proposed extension of natural gas service to the community of Cambria, San Luis Obispo County, and to deviate from the provisions of a service agreement with Pacific Gas and Electric Company authorized by Decision No. 65882, dated August 20, 1963, in Application No. 45065, with respect to boundary revisions of Rate Area 19, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 4573-G to 4576-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The utility will submit a rate of return report to the Commission following the third full year of operation and, if an extension allowance deficiency exists, will submit annual rate of return reports until the deficiency is eliminated, and

WHEREAS: In granting the authorization requested, the Commission states that if it should appear in future proceedings that there are deficiencies in earnings from this extension, such deficiencies are not to be imposed upon the utility's other gas customers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make the foregoing tariff sheets effective on September 12, 1967.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1388.
