SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rebate Plan for 1967 on Less Than
Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: San Diego Gas & Electric Company, by letter dated October 11, 1967, having requested authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to place into effect a rebate plan on less than statutory notice, namely by November 3, 1967, and

WHEREAS: This proposed rebate plan represents mainly the savings in federal and state income taxes for 1967 resulting from use of liberalized depreciation on plant additions for the years 1954-1964 inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Such rebate is proposed to be distributed by check or by credit to November, 1967 bills in its entirety among all eligible customers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code for San Diego Gas & Electric Company to place into effect by November 3, 1967, the rebate plan filed in October, 1967.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that San Diego Gas & Electric Company shall keep records of the refunds made and submit a report of the disposition of such monies to the Commission for a final disposition of any amounts unrefunded by May 31, 1968.
