SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from a Portion of Section 5.e.l. of General Order No. 94-A

WHEREAS: McCloud Gas Co., Inc., by letter dated October 24, 1967, having requested authority under Section 1 of General Order No. 94-A to deviate from the specified procedure required by Section 5.e.l. of this order with respect to the 20-year inspection of a liquid hydrocarbon storage vessel, as outlined in said letter, and

WHEREAS: The utility has requested the use of the non-destructive reflectoscope method when examining for internal corrosion during the inspection of its liquid hydrocarbon vessel located in McCloud, California, and

WHEREAS: If the results of any such test indicate that the vessel is in a defective or hazardous condition, it must be removed from service, repaired and tested in accordance with General Order No. 94-A before it is again placed in service, and

WHEREAS: Such deviation will relieve the utility from unnecessary expenses, hardship, disruption of service, and, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 1708 of the Public Utilities Code for McCloud Gas Co., Inc., to carry out the inspection procedure as outlined in its letter of October 24, 1967, under the condition stated herein.
