SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Territorial Boundary Lines
Which Will Result in Technical Increases

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 717, filed October 19, 1967, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make minor revisions in its common territorial boundary line with Southern Counties Gas Company of California as established by Decision No. 56878, dated June 24, 1958 in joint Application No. 39636, by modifying the common boundary so as to follow a more readily identifiable boundary as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 10095-G to 10102-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Portions of the areas revised will result in potentially increased charges over the rates now in effect, thus resulting in technical increases, and

WHEREAS: These boundary adjustments coincide with like changes concurrently granted by Resolution No. G-1399, for Southern Counties Gas Company, and

WHEREAS: We find that such technical increases resulting from the boundary line revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 490 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on regular statutory notice, namely, on November 18, 1967.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1398.
