RESOLUTION

**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges

**WHEREAS:** SOUTH TAHOE GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 15, filed February 9, 1968, having requested authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Rule No. 15, Gas Main Extensions, and Rule No. 16, Service Connections, Meters and Customer's Facilities, by increasing charges for excess gas pipe footage, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 98-G to 101-G, inclusive, and

**WHEREAS:** Said rules contain provisions covering revision of these charges when unit installation costs have changed by more than 10% and the proposed unit charges, based on 1966 construction costs, exceed the costs now on file by more than 10%, and

**WHEREAS:** The revision of these unit charges is being accomplished in accordance with the procedure authorized by Ordering Paragraph 5 of Decision No. 59801, dated March 22, 1960, in Case No. 5945, and

**WHEREAS:** We find that the increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

**IT IS ORDERED** that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on March 10, 1968.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1408.
