RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from Filed Tariffs for
a Gas Main Extension

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 732 filed
March 26, 1968, having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public
Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules by the waiving
of gas main extension advances for a proposed extension of natural gas
service to the community of Traver in Tulare County, as set forth on
Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 10154-G to 10158-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: In granting the authorization requested, the Commission states
that if it should appear in future proceedings that there are deficiencies
in earnings from this extension, such deficiencies are not to be imposed
upon the utility's other gas customers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public
Utilities Code to make the foregoing sheets effective on regular statutory
notice, namely on April 25, 1968, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they
were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State
of California No. G-1410.
